



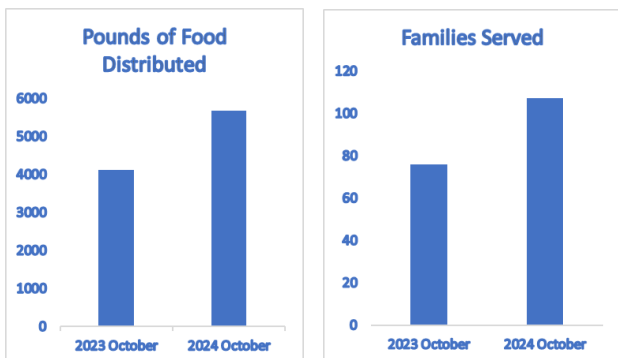

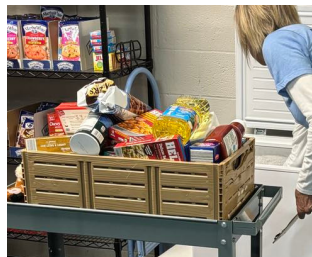


90 Children Provided Food
