Because clients realize they will not go hungry this month.



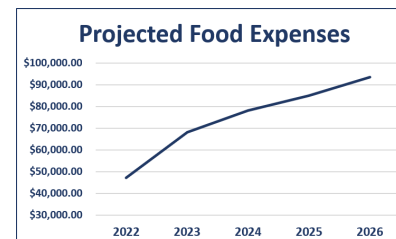
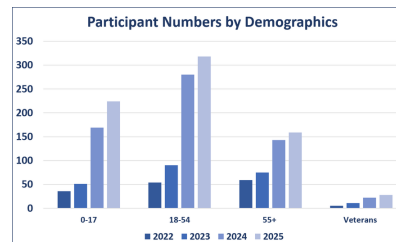
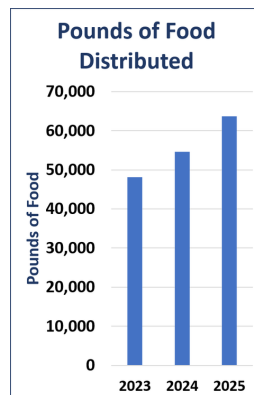
