At MOMS, we like for our shelves to be full to the brim when our clients come in for their "shopping experience". It helps our clients overcome the scarcity mentality and assures them that there is

plenty of food for everyone. Because of your generosity, we are able to fill our shelves each month and create a sense of abundance for families who are used to empty cupboards. We are able to offer lots of choices in each food category so that families can go home with enough food for 7 to 10 days compared to the normal 2-3 day supply most pantries offer.
